



*10th November 1933*

*The Great War made its presence felt on this night with the first Zeppelin raids, by the Fritzroviaian Air Force. Their target was the docks, which was seriously damaged by the bombing. Many warehouses were destroyed with many lives lost. However, heroic efforts by the dockers and others, meant that the docks were only out of action for a few days. The city suffered several more raids during the winter of 1933/1934.*
