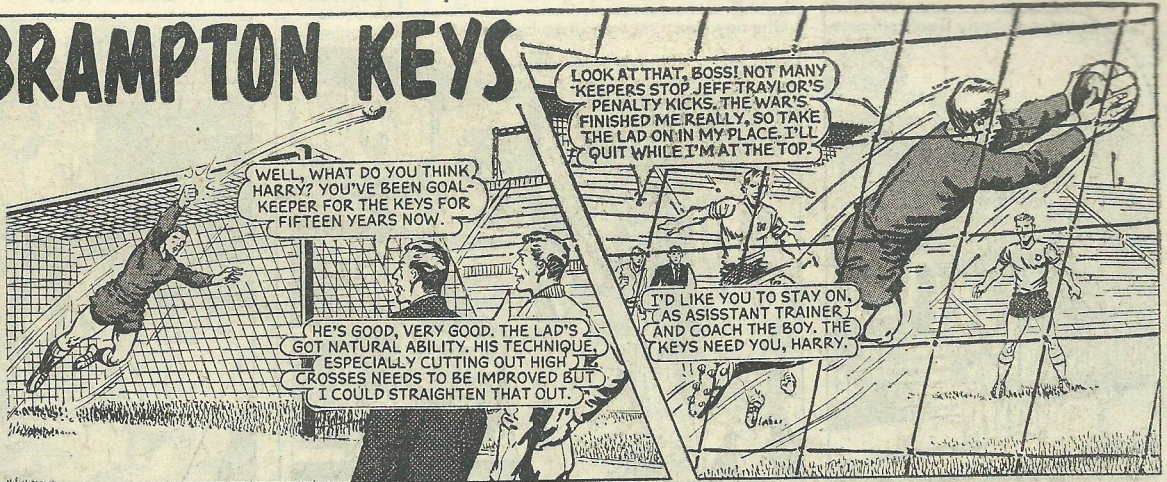


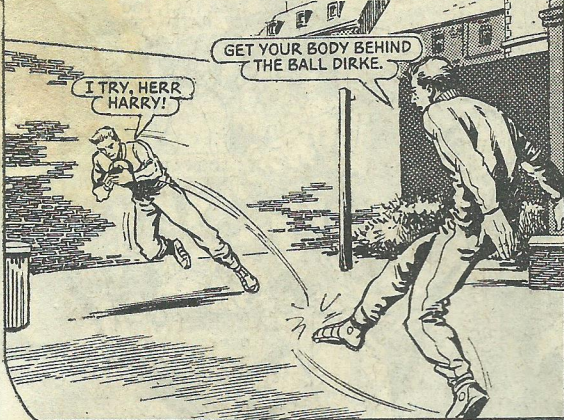

# The BRAMPTON KEYS

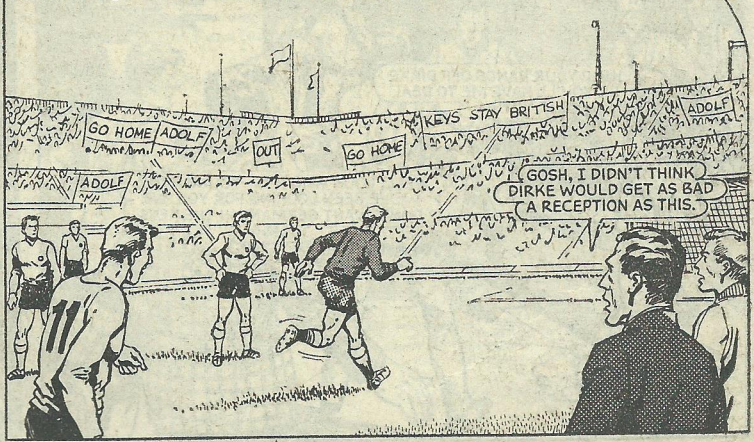

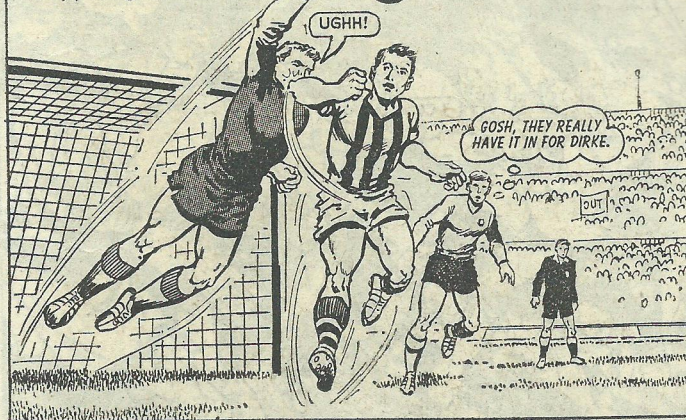
Dirke was signed by the Keys. Harry Wood had him round at his home for coaching every night.



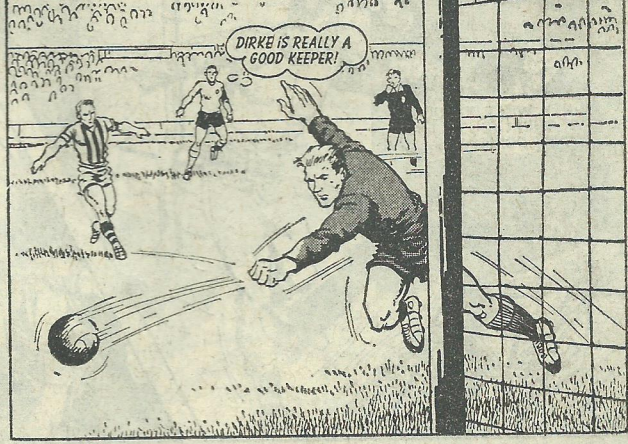
As the new goalkeeper ran out for his first game
