THE BRAMPTON KEYS

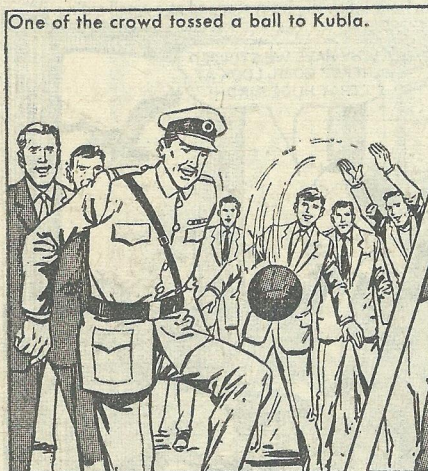

The crowd had also turned up to see Kubla, centre-forward of Kroslov Dynamo, for he was a national hero!

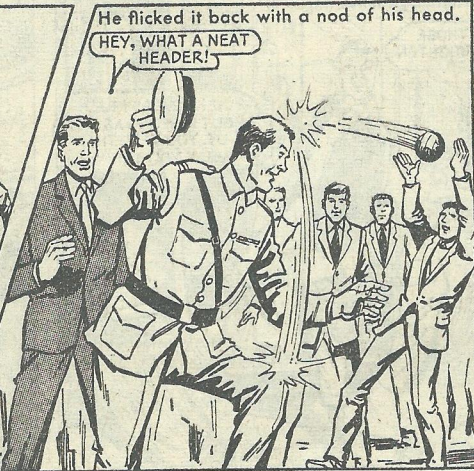


One of the crowd tossed a ball to Kubla.

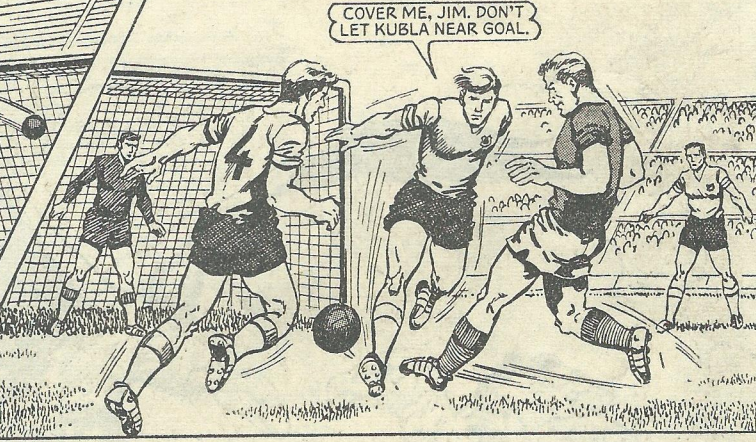
Kubla produced even more tricks that afternoon in a Kroslov training session.



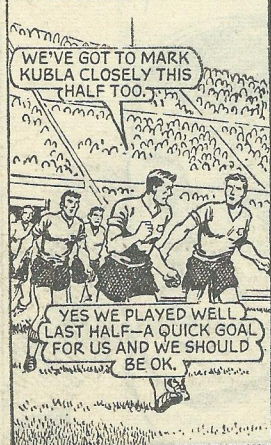

COVER ME, JIM. DON'T LET KUBLA NEAR GOAL.



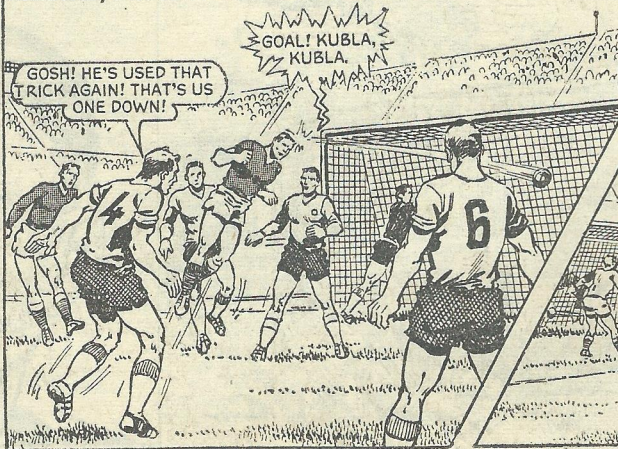
The second half.
