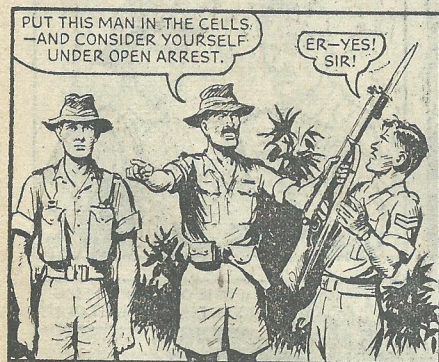


GREAT COMPLETE STORY! The Fourteenth Army thinks a human tornado has hit it when Major Mills arrives!

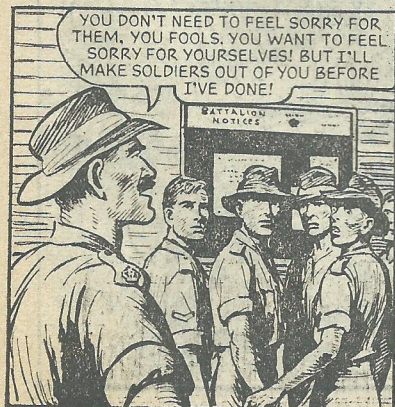
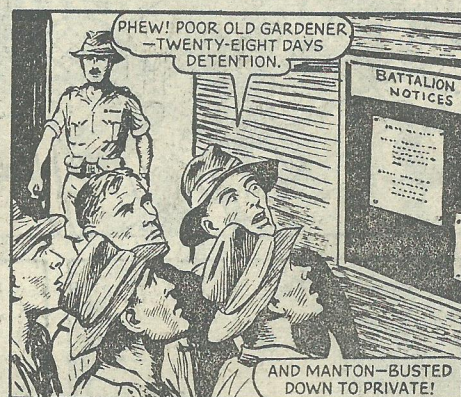
