



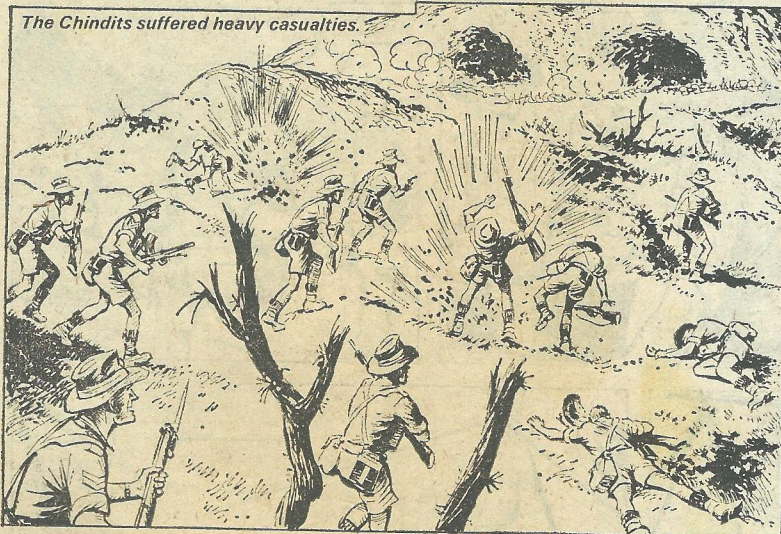
At the field kitchen set up behind the front line, Tucker kept an eagle eye on his trainee cooks.
