

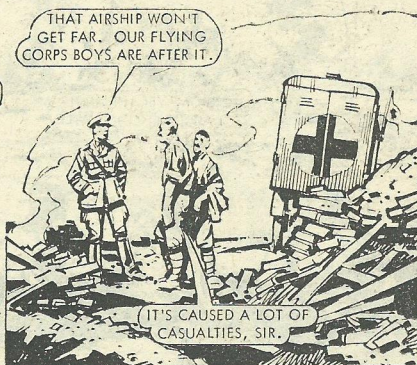
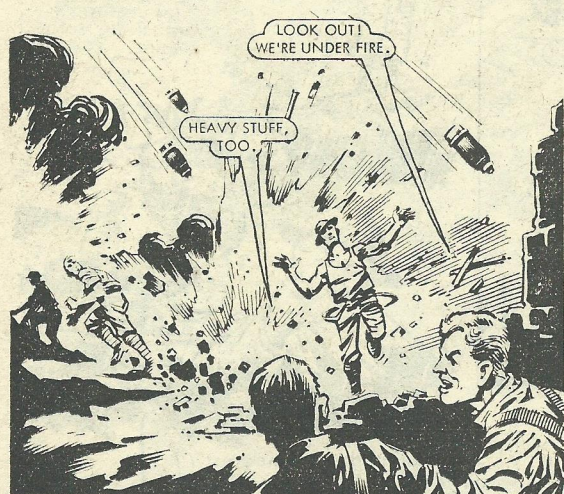
It's tough in the front line—but it's even worse behind it!

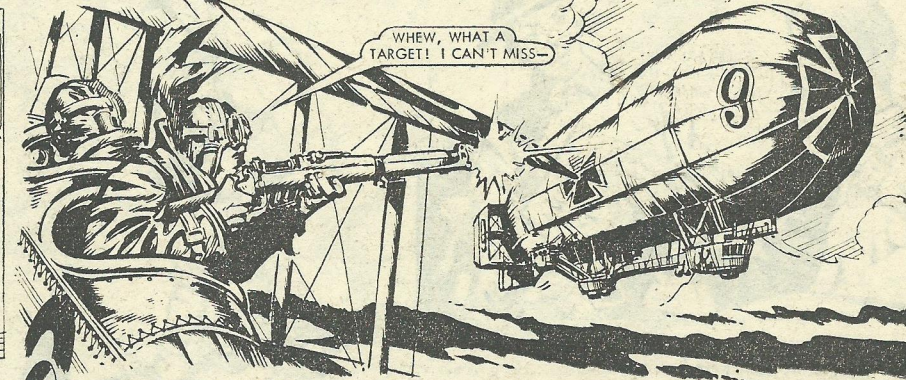
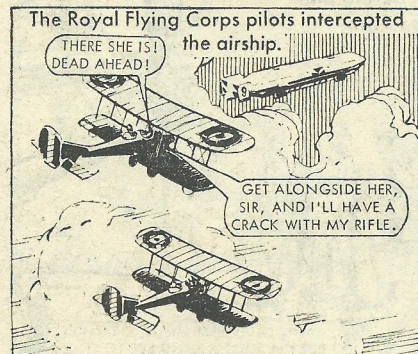
