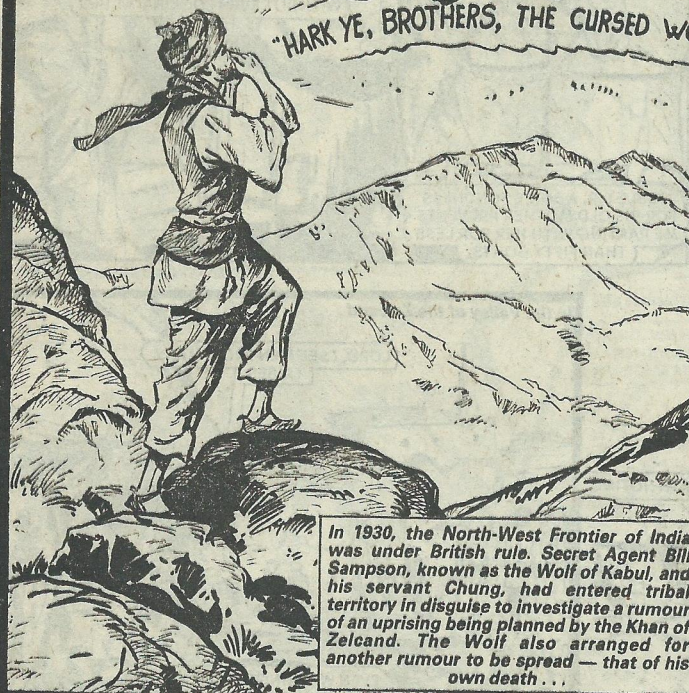
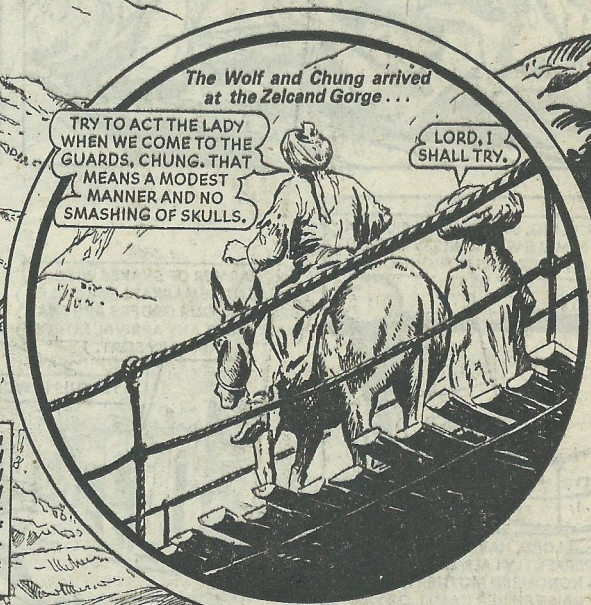


# The WOLF of KABUL
