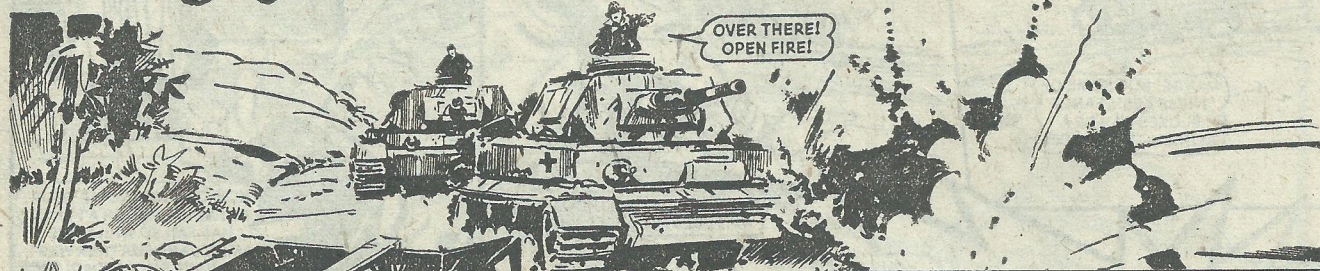


# KILL OR DIE!
