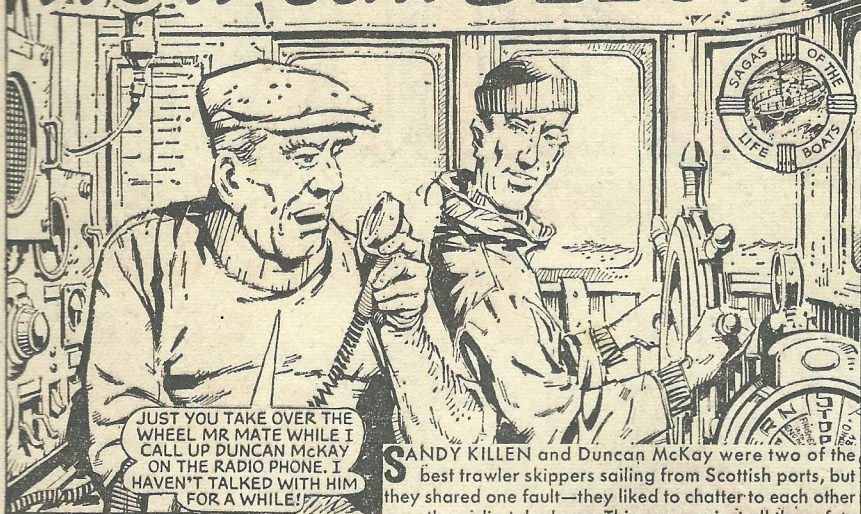


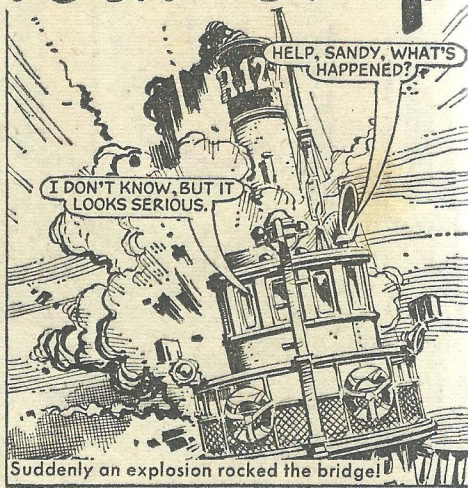
Meet the skipper who talked his trawler into trouble!

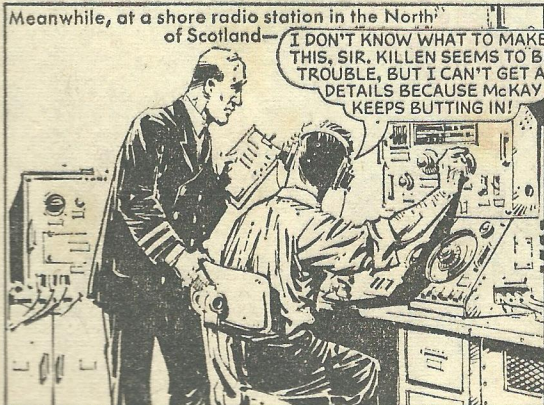
GET OFF THE PHONE, DUNCAN! THIS IS AN EMERGENCY!



I'VE PUT OUT THE SEA ANCHOR, SKIPPER.

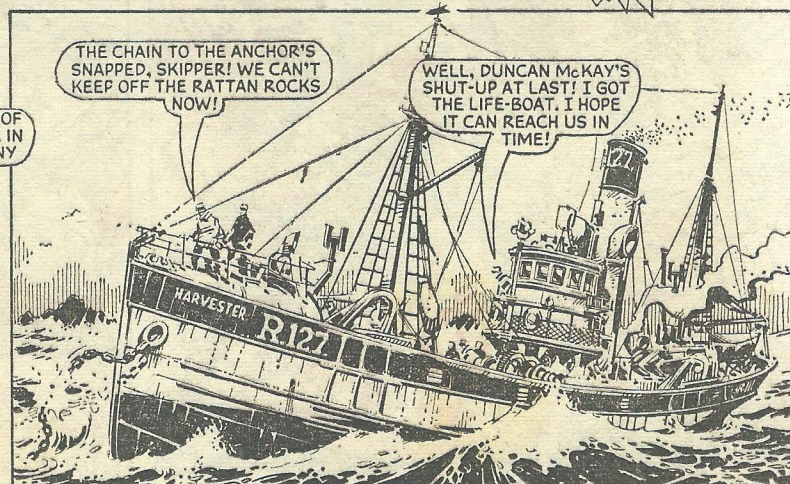
