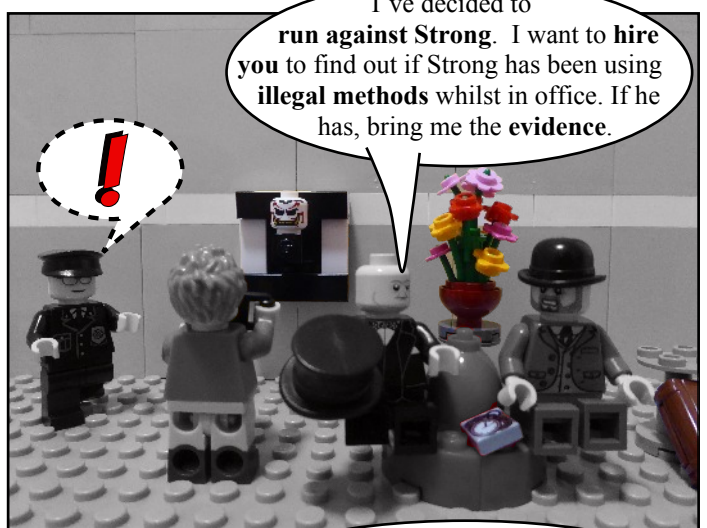




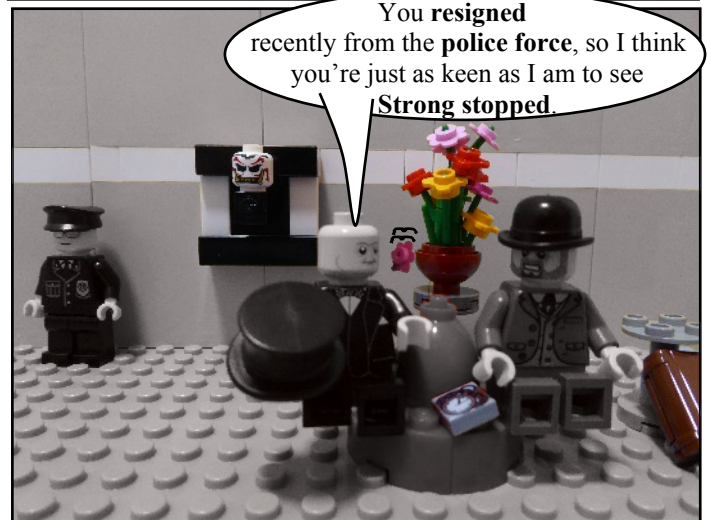
And I'm convinced not all of it was done **legally**. It's two years until the next council elections.

You **resigned** recently from the **police force**, so I think you're just as keen as I am to see **Strong stopped**.

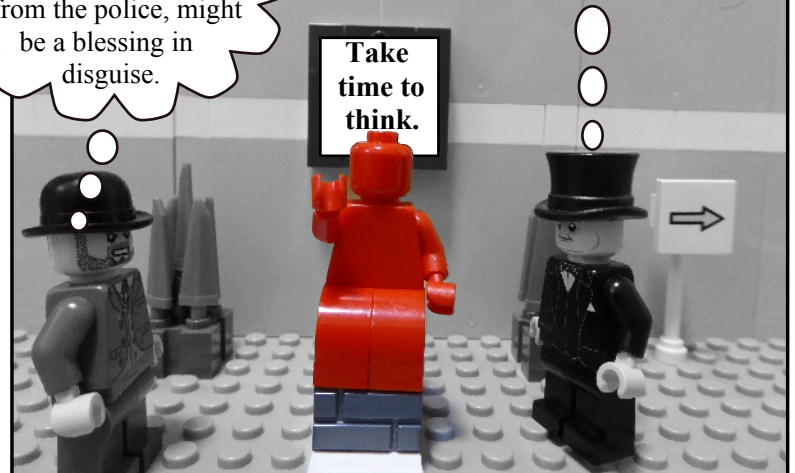
That's putting it mildly! I had been on the end of one to many dressing down's by Harrow.* I resigned in a blaze of anger.
