

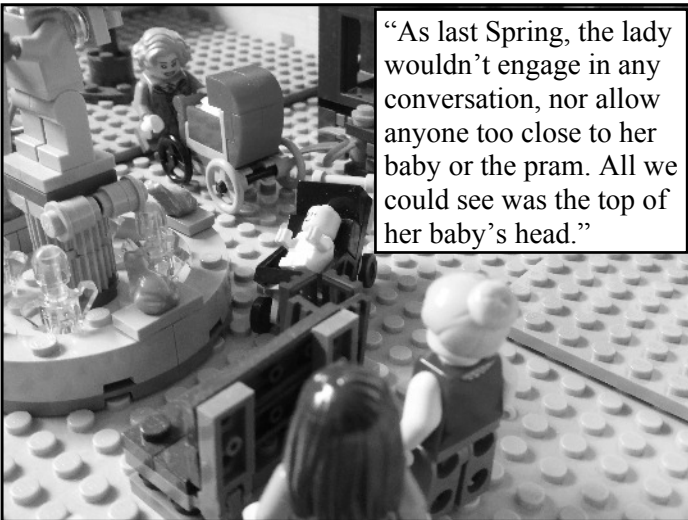

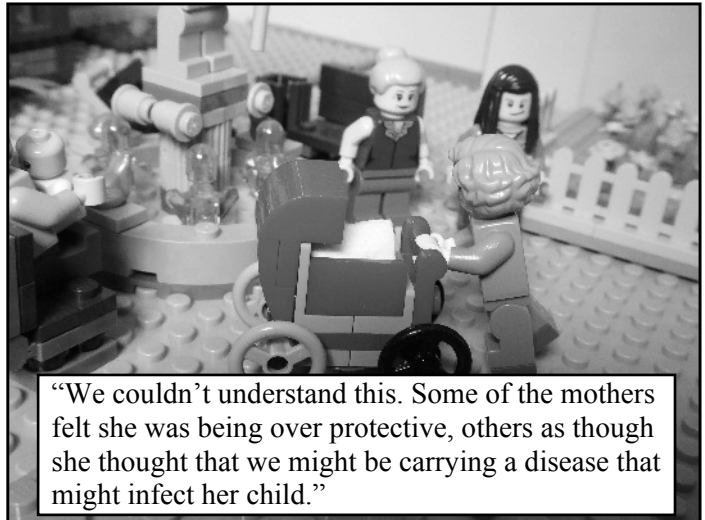
"And then this Spring she re-appeared, with her own child in a pram. Looking as pleased as all mothers are with their new off spring. We called her 'Proud Mother' "
