

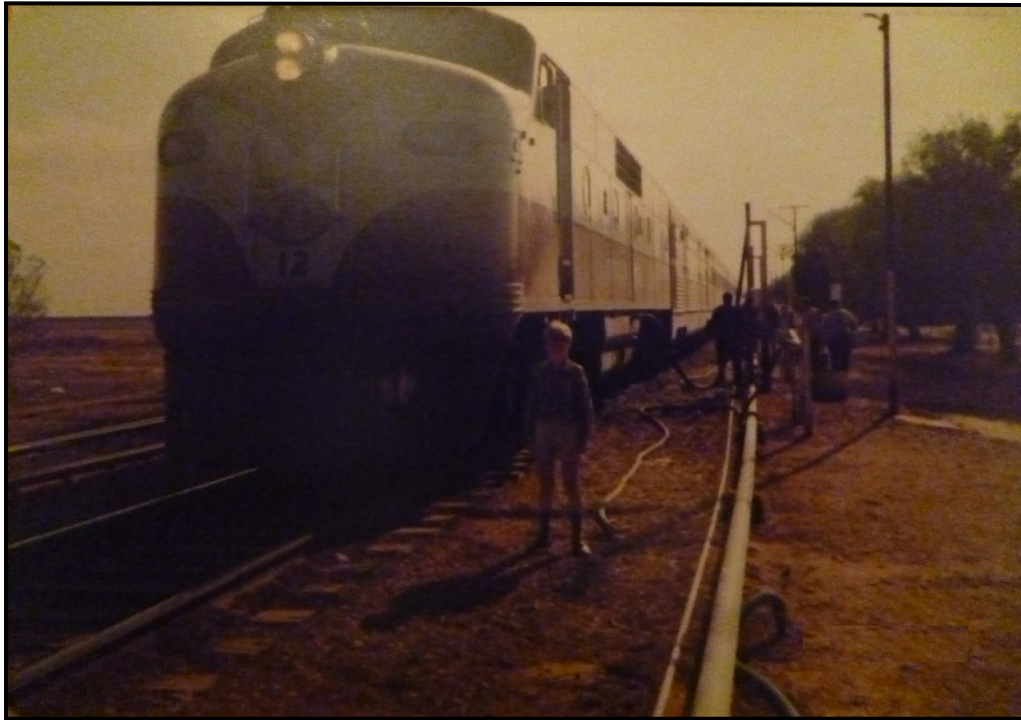

The view below is of my brother standing in front of our train's diesel locomotive at a refuelling stop at Cook, South Australia, approximately a third of the way along the longest stretch of straight railway line in the world. Known as the Golden Mile the straight railway line starts in South Australia and finishes in Western Australia, passing through the Nullarbor Plain.
