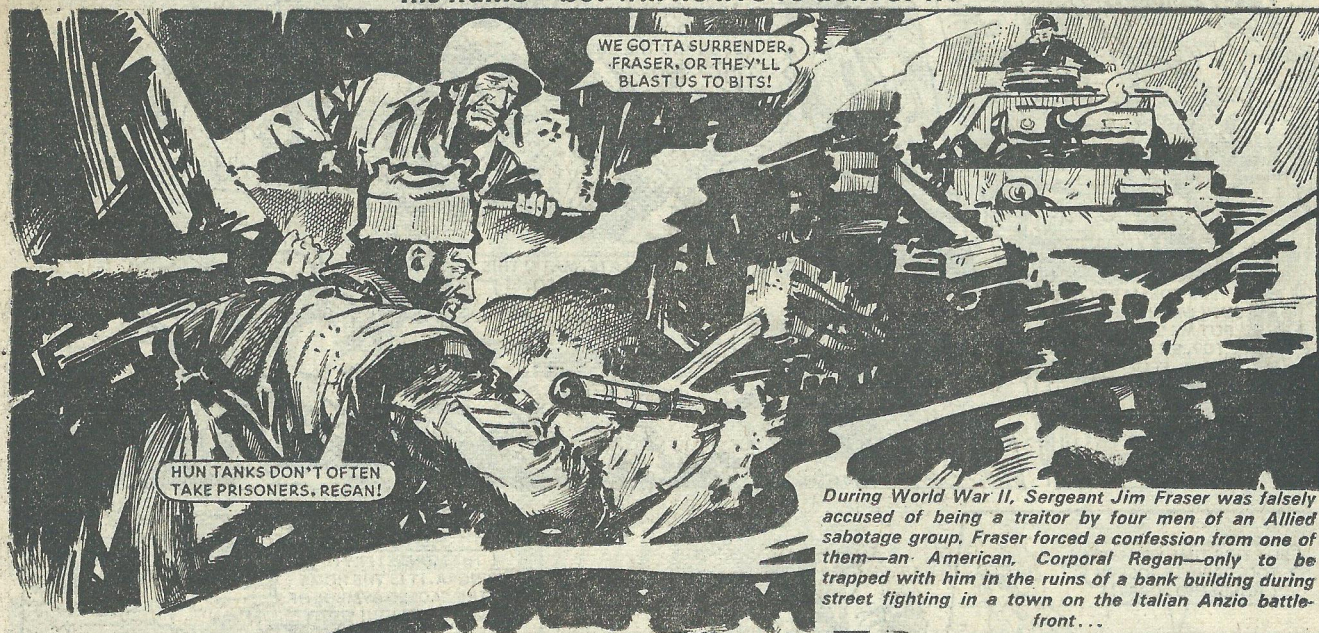


Fraser has a written confession that can clear his name—but will he live to deliver it?
