and sets the Germans fighting each other!**

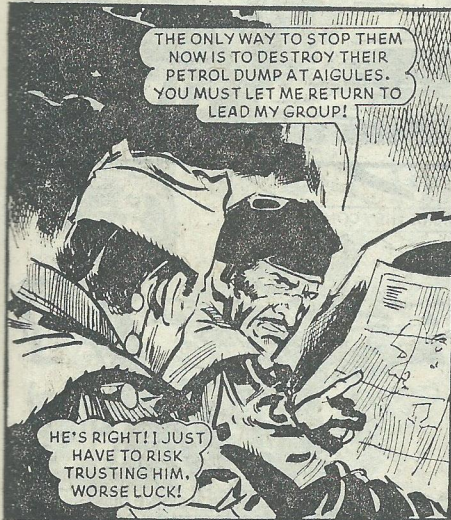

WORSE LUCK!

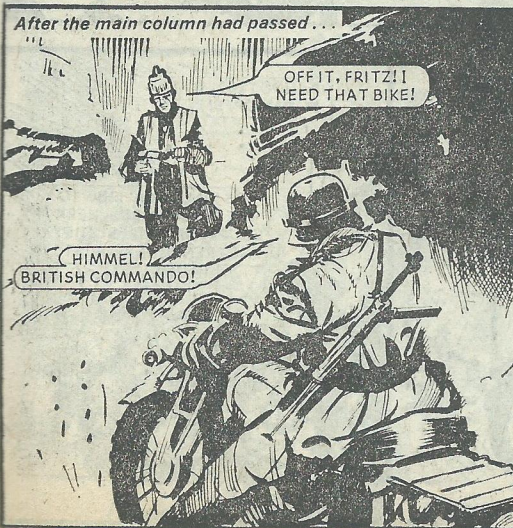


GO ON, THEN, MASSON!

After the main column had passed...

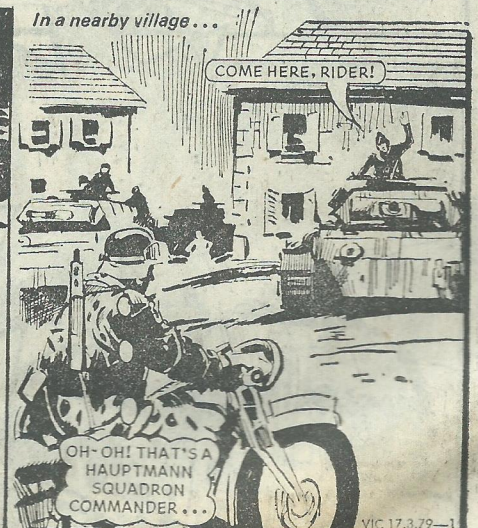
OFF IT, FRITZ! I
